Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 113 exempts motor vehicle usage tax for a vehicle previously registered in another state, and owned by a current or former member of the Armed Forces, provided that the motor vehicle was purchased when the owner was on active duty.

County Clerks receive a portion of motor vehicle usage taxes as a fee for handling the transfer.

HB 113 is expected to have a minimal negative fiscal impact on county clerk revenue. The total amount of possible lost revenue is indeterminable.
