Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

HB 188/GA would establish a driveway plate as a new type of plate to be issued by county clerks and the Transportation Cabinet. A driveway plate allows a vehicle that has a valid registration of a declared gross vehicle weight to be operated in a driveway service, and is reusable until the driveway plate expires or is revoked. A driveway business that holds a driveway certificate will be issued a certificate of registration and one initial plate when paying the fee of \$150. Additional driveway plates may be issued for a fee of \$35. County clerks will retain \$15 for each additional plate issued.

The Transportation Cabinet has identified that there is currently only one driveway account holder in the Commonwealth.

The fiscal impact of HB 188/GA is expected to be minimal, but positive to county clerk revenue.
