Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

The fiscal impact of HB 213 on local governments is indeterminable. It can be presumed that for local governments that have not enacted policies that allow for sanctuary cities, many of the obligations herein will run parallel to responsibilities local law enforcement currently handles. If a local government has enacted policies creating a sanctuary city, they may incur attorney fees to amend the current policy as well as expenditures for the custody and retention of inmates outlined in this measure.
