Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

Section 1 of HB 387/HCS 1 limits the allowable expenditures of metropolitan sewer districts and would not have a fiscal impact on local governments.

Section 2 of HB 387/HCS 1 would amend KRS 76.030 to allow the county judge/executive of a county served by a metropolitan sewer district located in an adjoining county to appoint an additional member to the metropolitan sewer district board. However, sewer districts within consolidated local governments would be exempt from this provision.

HB 387/HCS 1 would have a negligible fiscal impact on county governments and would have no impact on Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government or the adjoining counties.

HB 387 may result in minor administrative costs to some county fiscal courts related to the appointment of an additional member to a metropolitan sewer district board. These costs may include staff time for reviewing and processing appointments, coordinating

with the metropolitan sewer district, and any related administrative tasks. However, these expenses are expected to be minimal.

Louisville-Jefferson County is the only consolidated government in Kentucky, and KRS 76.030 does not apply to it. If the Louisville Metropolitan Sewer District were to serve any of the adjoining counties, (Bullitt, Hardin, Oldham, Shelby, or Spencer) HB 387/HCS 1 would not apply.
