<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: The measure requests the Kentucky Supreme Court to conduct a pilot project on the use of artificial intelligence for transcription services in court proceedings.

<u>FISCAL EXPLANATION</u>: The request for the pilot project is permissive only and would require initiation by the Supreme Court and acceptance by judges in their respective participating districts or circuits. Absent an appropriation from the General Assembly, if the Supreme Court chose to initiate the pilot project it would need to be with other available funds. It is unknown at this time what the estimated cost of the pilot would be.
