<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: The purpose of the measure is to limit the number of Medicaid managed care (MCO) contracts to no more than three effective January 1, 2027.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** The Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS, Cabinet) estimates that the Department for Medicaid Services (DMS) would incur procurement related costs of \$2.8 million total, with \$1.4 million in General Fund and \$1.4 million in Federal Funds. However, the Cabinet did not specify how the estimate was derived. Given the lack of data, the fiscal effect is indeterminable.
