PURPOSE OF MEASURE: SB 186 proposes to remove the petition process for recalling a local property tax rate and mandates that the levy of a local property tax rate which will produce revenue from real property, exclusive of revenue from new property, that is more than four percent over the amount of revenue produced by the compensating tax rate be put before the voters of the district. The bill establishes requirements for the ballot question, notifying the public about the election, the election process, and the process for recalling the tax rate. It allows the local taxing district to cancel the election by reconsidering the tax rate levy and levying the compensating tax rate instead. It prohibits state, local, and federal tax dollars to be used to advocate for the levy of the tax rate.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: SB 186 pertains to the levy of a property tax rate by a local taxing district and does not expect to have a fiscal impact on state revenues.
