**<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>**: The measure establishes the Agricultural Economic Development Board and creates the Agricultural Economic Development Fund for the purpose of awarding state grants to agricultural projects that promote economic development, alternative fuels use, and high technology energy jobs.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** The newly created five-member Agricultural Economic

Development Board is attached administratively to the Department of Agriculture. Members are entitled to reimbursement of expenses while traveling and conducting board business. Typically, a fiscal impact of a few thousand dollars is assigned to a new board. In this case, the Department of Agriculture has indicated they have existing financial resources from 24 RS SB 91 with which to compensate board members. Therefore, because this measure does not appropriate any monies to the Agricultural Economic Development Fund, there is no state fiscal impact associated with the measure.
