<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: The measure establishes the Agricultural Economic Development Board and creates the Agricultural Economic Development Fund for the purpose of awarding state grants and loans to agricultural projects that promote economic development.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The newly created six-member Agricultural Economic Development Board is attached administratively to the Kentucky Office of Agricultural Policy, but receives significant input from the Cabinet for Economic Development. Members are entitled to reimbursement of expenses while traveling and conducting board business. Typically, a fiscal impact of a few thousand dollars is assigned to a new board. In this case, the Department of Agriculture has indicated they have existing financial resources from 24 RS SB 91 with which to compensate board members.
