<u>PURPOSE OF MEASURE</u>: The purpose of the measure is to create a new offense of criminal atmospheric pollution, which would be a Class D felony and carry an associated \$500,000 civil penalty.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The measure's fiscal impact is indeterminable but could increase incarceration costs for the Department of Corrections. Class D felons serve 1-to-5-year sentences at a cost of \$17,313 annually. A person convicted would also be subject to a \$500,000 civil penalty payable to the Commonwealth. How many offenders may be convicted of the new offense and be subject to the associated sentence and civil penalty is unknown.
