Part II: Bill Provisions and the Estimated Fiscal Impact Relating to Local Government

SB 63/HCS 1 allows street-legal special purpose vehicles to be registered and operated on a highway under certain circumstances.

Under the provisions of SB 63/HCS 1, county clerks are required to title and register special purpose vehicles. Per KRS 186.040, the county clerks retain \$6 of the registration fee. SB 63/HCS 1 retains the \$25 fee for the certification of a special purpose vehicle paid to the sheriff's office. An exact dollar figure for how much such fees would increase county clerk and sheriff's office revenue is indeterminable since it is not known how many special purpose vehicles will be registered.

The fiscal impact of SB 63/HCS 1 is indeterminable, but could increase clerk and sheriff's office fee revenue with more registrations being processed for special purpose vehicles.
