PURPOSE OF MEASURE: House Bill 307 establishes a statewide proactive admissions program that notifies each eligible high school student of their eligibility for admission to a Kentucky public postsecondary education institution and provides instructions to apply. The bill requires the Kentucky Department of Education to submit student data, and institutions to set minimum standards for admission. It also directs the Council on Postsecondary Education to send personalized prospective admissions letters to each eligible high school student and create a website for students to apply using a common online application.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: The estimated fiscal impact of this bill is \$200,000 each fiscal year. This amount reflects the cost of printing and mailing notifications to approximately 55,000 students annually, as well as programming and organizing student data.
